

Replay the Last Macro

A neat feature of WordPerfect 6.x is the ability to play one of the last ten macros you've previously played. I've created two macros in WP 5.1 to repeat the last macro played. They are included as PLAY.WPM and REPEAT.WPM.

Now you need to add these macros to an existing keyboard. To do this, press (Shift-F1), (5) Keyboard Layout, highlight the keyboard you want to add the macros to and press (7) Edit. (You could also create a new keyboard by pressing (Shift-F1), (4) Create, then typing a keyboard name. Press (Enter), then press (7) Edit to add the macros.)

In the Keyboard: Edit menu, press (7) Retrieve, and at the Key: prompt press (Alt-F10). At the Macro: prompt, type "play" and press (Enter) to assign PLAY.WPM to (Alt-F10).

Next, press (7) Retrieve, and at the Key: prompt press (Alt-R). At the Macro: prompt, type "repeat" and press (Enter) to assign REPEAT.WPM to (Alt-R).

Now that you've assigned both macros, press Exit (F7) and (1) Select to select the desired keyboard. Press Exit (F7) again to return to the document screen.

After you've played a macro and you want to play it again, press (Alt-R). The macro you just played will be repeated.

Notes:

- *Keystroke macros will not work with this process; only macros that are played with (Alt-F10).*
- *Some macros will not repeat, for example, those that go out to the file manager (F5).*
